Dear Parents/Guardians and Sixth Grade Students,

Welcome to the Atlantic Middle School community. It is both an exciting and anxious time for all. Parents and students are always very concerned about the many adjustments that will occur in a new school and grade. Grade 6 students will assemble at the main door under the school sign and report to the auditorium for homeroom assignments.
