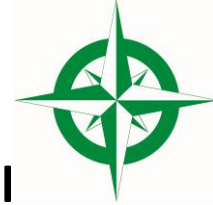
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#### **Learning Strategies**

**Time:** 7:45-8:15 am

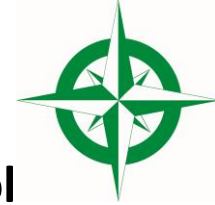

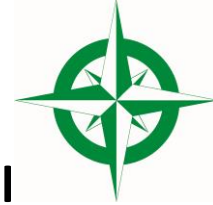
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#### **Gr. 5 Robotics**

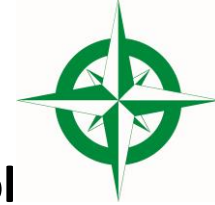

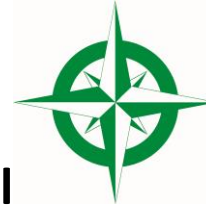
