

PHYSICAL EXAMINATIONS OF STUDENTS – FILE 10.11.1

Every student must submit documentation of a completed physical examination by a physician registered in Massachusetts within six months before entrance to school and upon admittance to the fourth, seventh and tenth grades thereafter.

ATHLETICS

In accordance with the Massachusetts Interscholastic Athletic Association regulations, Quincy Public Schools requires that all students must pass a physical examination within thirteen months of participating in interscholastic athletics at the start of each season. The physical examination must be on file before a student can participate in tryouts, practices or games. Students who meet the criteria at the start of the season will remain eligible for that season. Physical examinations must be performed by a registered physician, physician's assistant or nurse practitioner. Physical examinations are available on scheduled dates from the school physician during the school year. See Health Services Manual for further procedures in protocol and procedures.
