Practice Taking the Accuplacer Test



The purpose of the **Accuplacer** tests is to evaluate the mathematics, reading and writing skills of students entering college. ACCUPLACER supports students ready to start earning credits toward their degree as well as those who need to develop their skills before taking college-level courses. ACCUPLACER scores let students know where they stand academically, which makes it easier for them to plan a successful path toward a college degree.

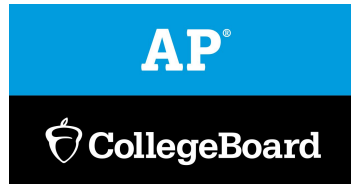

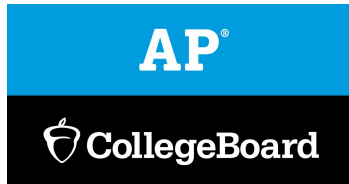

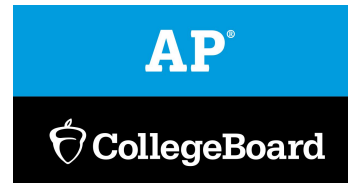
