Dear Quincy Public Schools Parents and Guardians,

As of March 16, 2020, Quincy Public Schools will be serving meals to students of Quincy, MA in a non-congregate manner in response to the necessity of social distancing due to the COVID-19 outbreak. A “grab and go” breakfast and lunch will be served during the weeks of school closures at the following locations:

- North Quincy High School
- Quincy High School
- Snug Harbor Elementary School
- Lincoln Hancock

Breakfast and lunch service is Monday through Friday at 11:00 AM -12:00 PM during school closure. As a precaution, participants will not enter the school buildings, but meals will be handed out at the main entrance of the building. Once you receive the meal, please promptly leave the school grounds to maintain social distancing with other participants.

The majority of the meals will be cold items. We ask that participants consume the contents of the meal within an hour of receiving it or refrigerate the meal immediately. In the event that we provide cold meals that need to be heated, participants will be informed of this and the following heating guidelines must be followed:

- With a fork poke holes in the top of the plastic sealed container
- Place in the microwave on high for 90 seconds
- Remove plastic seal and enjoy
